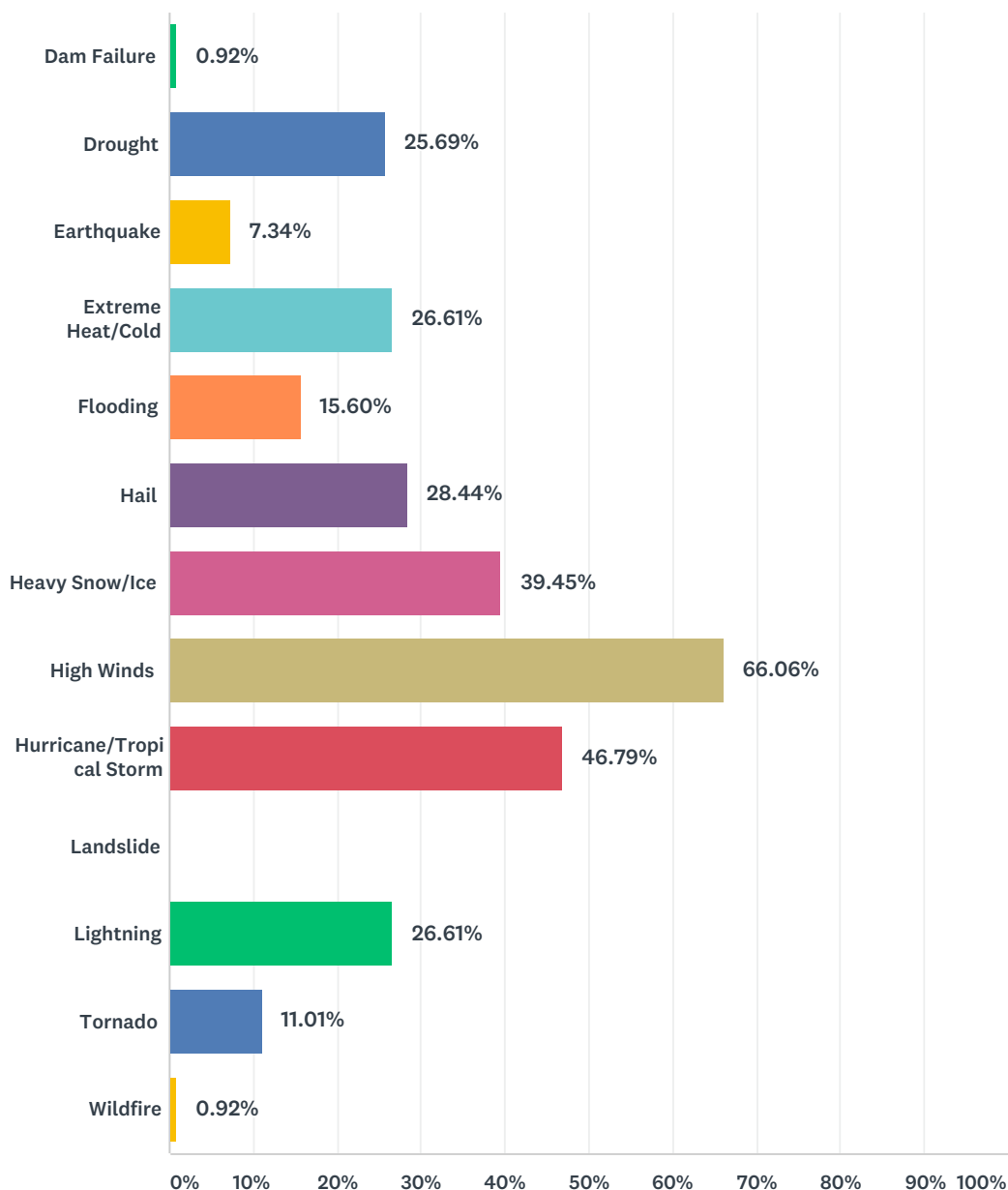


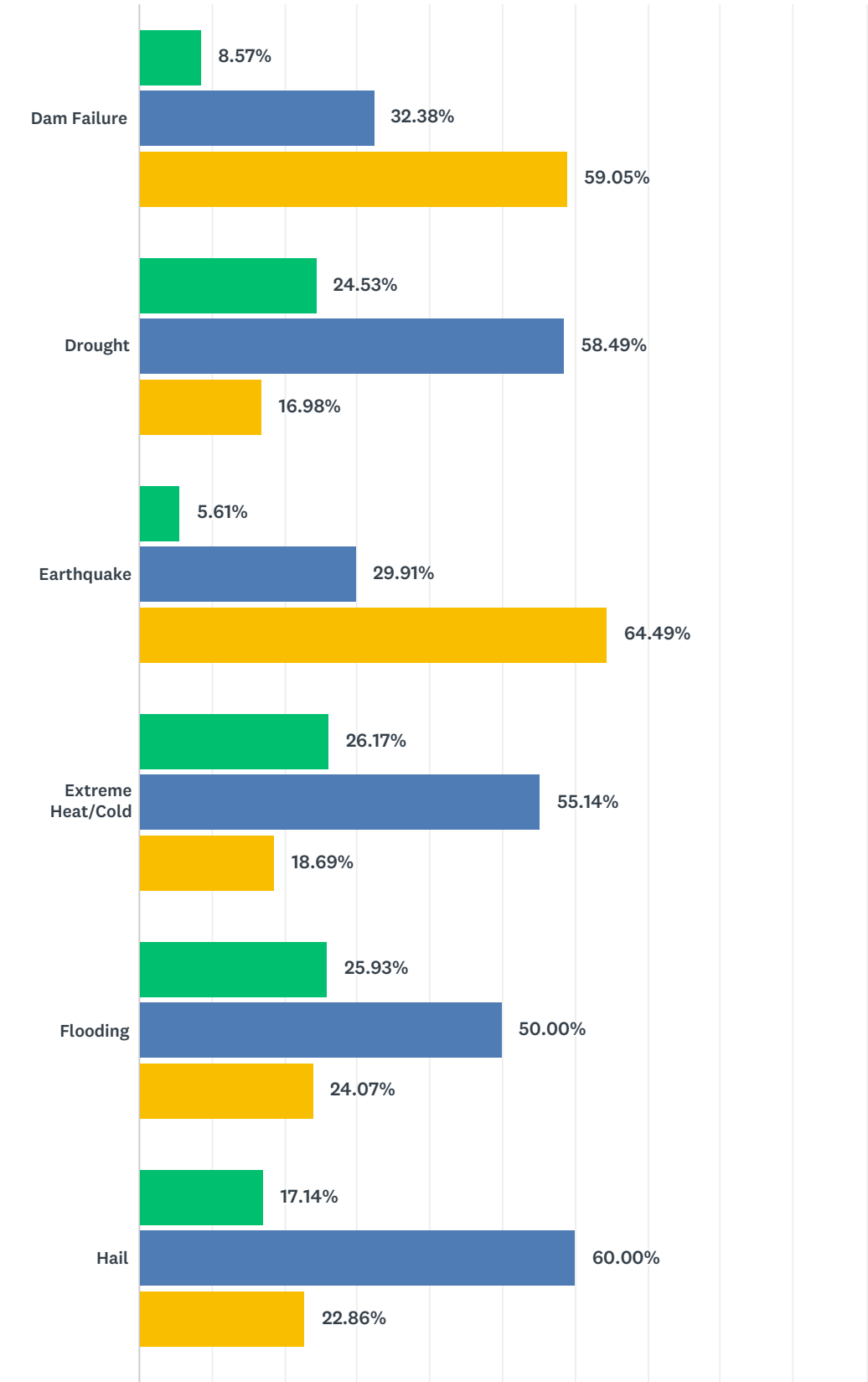
## Q1 Which of the following hazards have directly impacted you, your household, or your property?

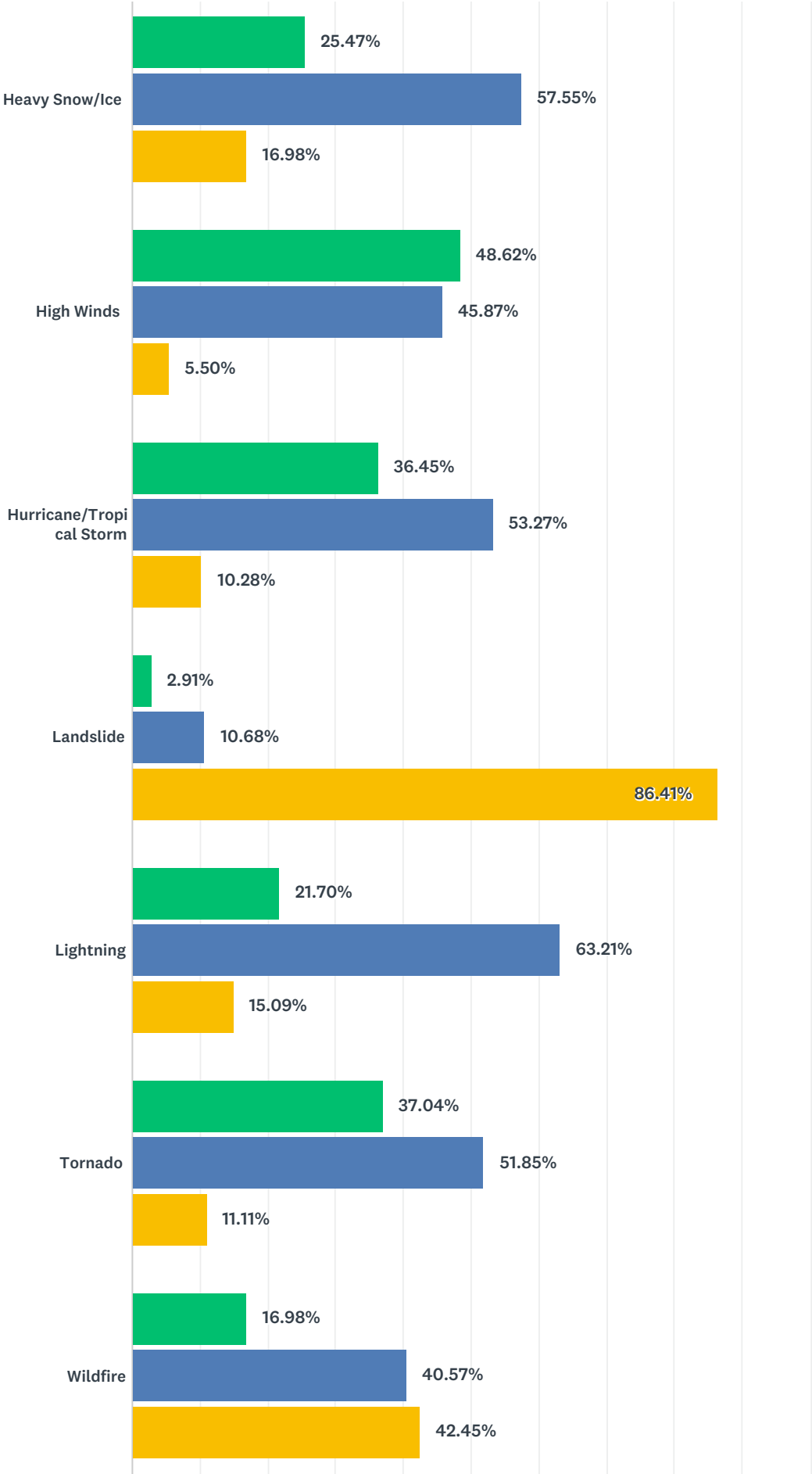

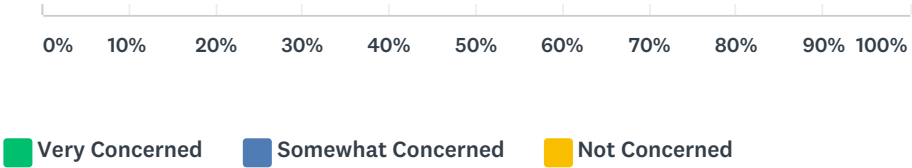


Q2 How concerned are you about the following hazards affecting our region?

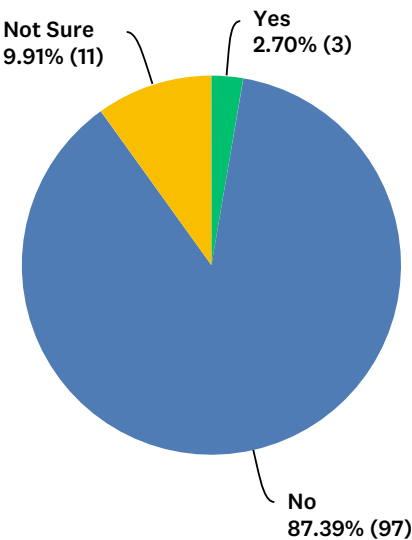






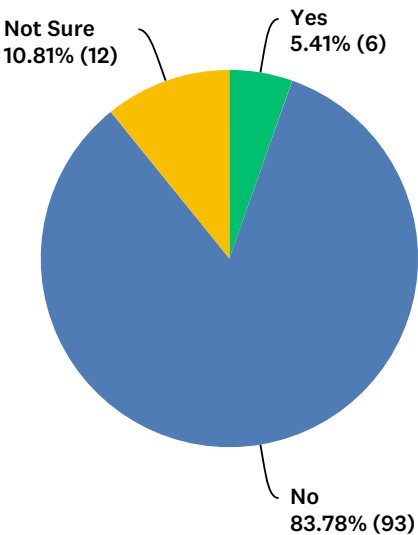
Q3 Is your home located in a floodplain?

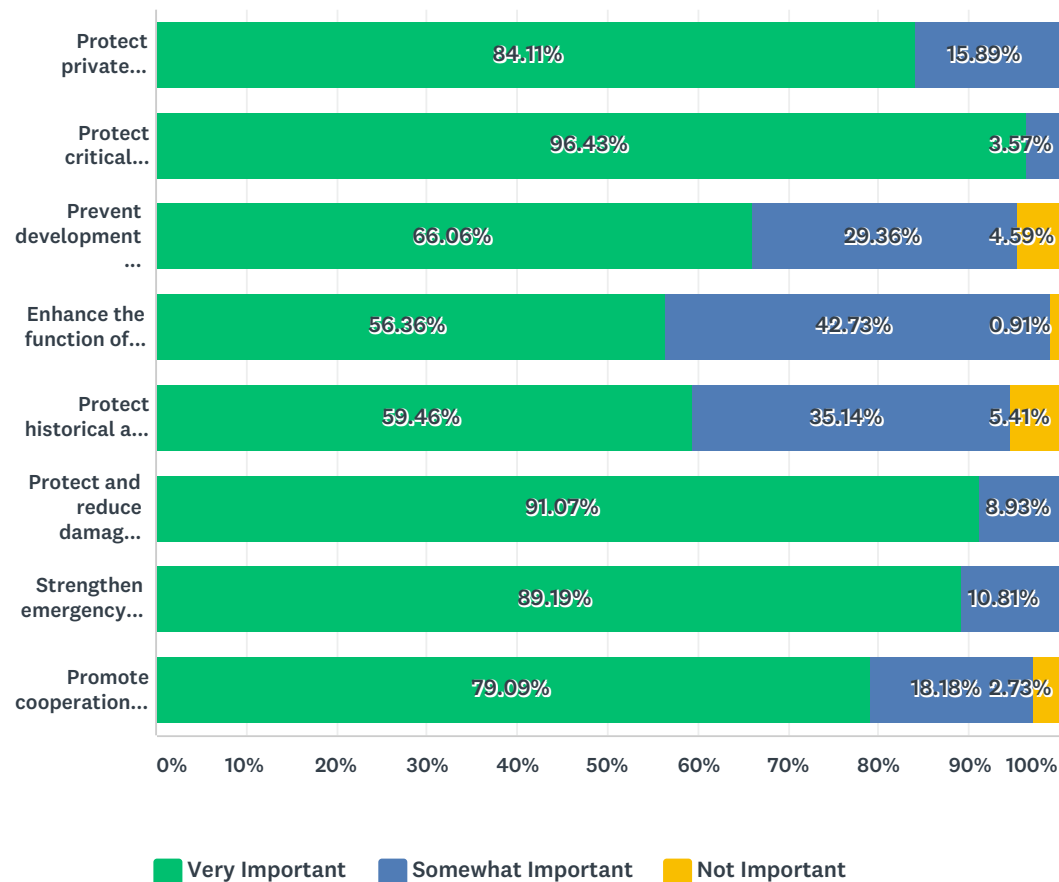
Q4 Does your household have flood insurance?

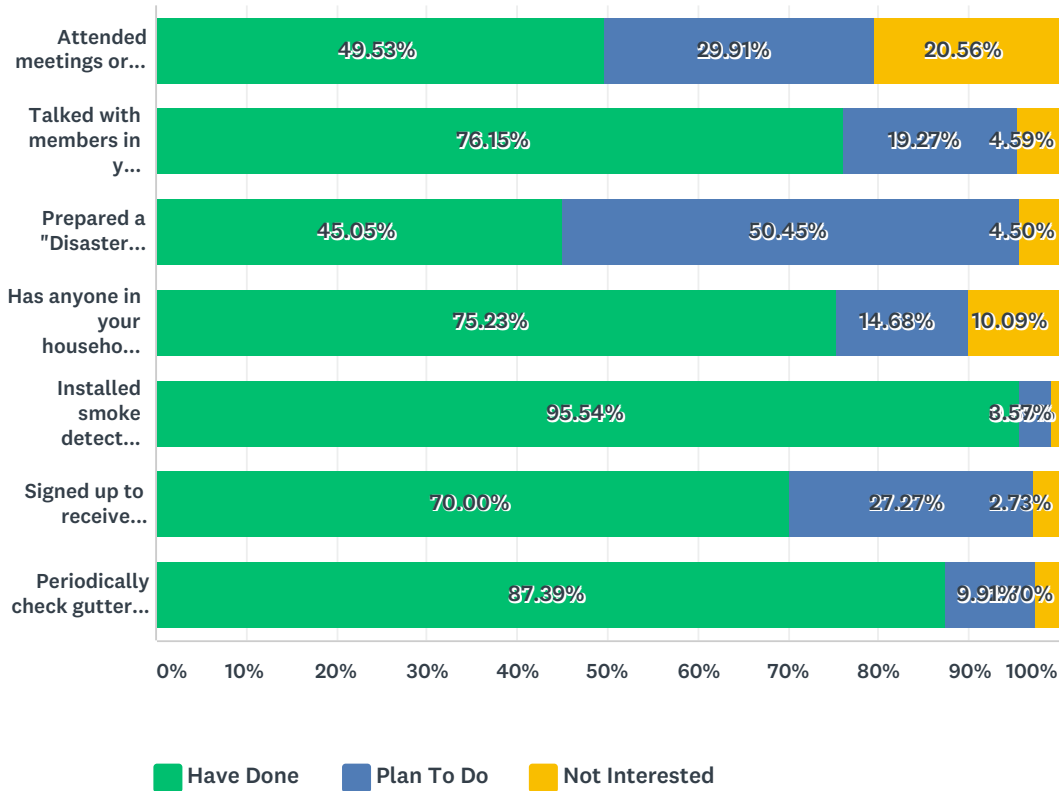

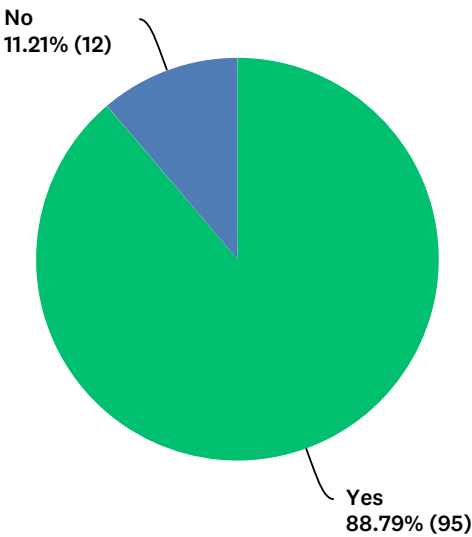
